



TILLANDSIA

Grow your reptile, amphibian, or invertebrate jungle with ReptiFauna™ tropical air plants.

These plants are perfect for naturally enhancing your animal habitat and are easy to care for. Tillandsia plants do not need to be in substrate, and take in nutrients from the circulating air surrounding them.

For easy planting, place them in open nooks and crannies of the habitat where they will receive proper light and access to being watered.

TIPS:

- Does not need substrate to grow.
- Provide good air circulation for best growth.
- Curled Leaves are a sign of needing water.
- Water more frequently in dry environments by soaking in de-chlorinated water.

TO GET STARTED:

- Gently shake any excess debris from the roots and discard in the debris trash
- Soak the plant in a shallow dish of water for 20-30 minutes
- Gently shake off the excess water and place in a warm dry spot to completely dry off
- Place the plant in a secure spot in your habitat, ensuring to not crush the roots
- Water according to the care instructions above, always using room temperature water
