



# HOYA

## TIPS:

- Allow the substrate to become completely dry between watering
- Dropping leaves is a sign that the Hoya plant is being overwatered
- Hoyas thrive in warm, humid habitats

## TO GET STARTED:

- Prepare the substrate by digging a small two inch hole to accommodate the plant
- Remove the plant from the pot being careful to not damage the roots
- Gently remove as much substrate from the plant and discard the substrate in the trash
- Lightly rinse the plant under de-chlorinated room temperature, or distilled water
- Place the plant in the hole in the substrate
- Fill in the open areas in the hole with substrate until it covers just up to the base of the plant
- Gently smooth out the substrate
- Water according to care directions above, always using room temperature water
