



# PITCHER PLANT

Grow your reptile, amphibian, or invertebrate jungle with ReptiFauna™ tropical plants.

## TIPS:

- Keep the substrate moist at all times, but not waterlogged
- Pitcher plants need at least 10 hours of light each day. Pale plants may indicate that the plant is not receiving enough light
- Pitcher plants are sensitive to high amounts of minerals found in tap water. If you live in an area with hard water, be sure to always use distilled water

## TO GET STARTED:

- Prepare the substrate by digging a small two inch hole to accommodate the plant
- Remove the plant from the pot being careful to not damage the roots
- Gently remove as much substrate from the plant and discard the substrate in the trash
- Lightly rinse the plant under de-chlorinated room temperature, or distilled water
- Place the plant in the hole in the substrate
- Fill in the open areas in the hole with substrate until it covers just up to the base of the plant
- Gently smooth out the substrate
- Water according to care directions above, always using room temperature water
